


Where to go.....

to help you find your way I've put together this map of the neighbourhood with places I know + can recommend for breakfast, having a drink, dinner or for shopping, visiting the chemist, renting a bike or going to the movies! Enjoy.



The Neighbourhood

The Hermann is located to the north of the Neukölln district and lies just below Kreuzberg. These neighbouring areas, also known as “Kreuzkölln”, are home to plenty of places to eat, drink, and explore. From the Schillerkiez to the Graefekiez, and all along the Landwehr Canal, here you will find a wide range of cosy cafes, delicious restaurants, and candlelit bars.

Getting Around

The closest U-Bahn (underground station) is HERMANN-PLATZ and is serviced by the U8 & U7 lines. The U8 (direction Wittenau) will take you to Alexanderplatz. This is a main shopping hub and also allows you to ride the S-Bahn (above ground train) and RE (regional trains) for other destinations. The opposite direction of the U8 will quickly take you to Hermannstrasse. From here you can connect with additional S-Bahn lines such as the ring (S41, S42), or the S45, which takes you directly to Schönefeld Airport.

B **Kaffeebar Jacobi** · Karl-Marx-Straße 4
Just around the corner from the apartment. This is a great spot for coffee with both indoor and outdoor seating areas that look across the charming St. Jacobi cemetery. Open from 11:00 Tues – Sun, closed on Mondays.

This French eatery is open for breakfast, lunch and dinner, serving perfect croissants, cheese platters, and a changing dinner menu. Breakfast from 9:00 on weekdays, and 10:00 on weekends.

24/7 restaurant serving Köfte sandwiches – Turkish grilled meat, soft bread, and lots of fresh herbs. Traditional soups and vegetarian options available.

Delicious ramen noodles with an outdoor area during summer. The restaurant is always packed due to its popularity, but is absolutely worth the fast wait time.

BARS

Rooftop bar on top of the “Neukölln Arcaden” shopping mall. Enter the mall and catch the elevator by the Post-Office to the 5th floor, then continue through the car park up to the rooftop. Great spot for sunsets and live music.

Natural wine bar with a weekly selection of wines by the glass. A paired menu of small plates is also available for those who are looking for a bite to eat.



Nathanja und Heinrich – Weichselstraße 44

A typical Neukölln spot adorned with rough floors and walls, second-hand furniture, and candlelit tables. A busy yet relaxed atmosphere with multiple rooms, and some outdoor benches during the summertime. Walk along Weichselstraße and the perpendicular Weserstraße for plenty more similar bar options.



Keith Bar - Schillerpromenade 2

Whiskey and German craft beer are served at this moody Neukölln bar – a very relaxed atmosphere with DJ's playing on weekends.



Geist im Glas - Lenaustraße 27

A cosy, candle-lit cocktail bar open 7 days a week. On weekends enjoy generous brunch portions of pancakes, huevos rancheros eggs, or southern biscuits & gravy, with delicious brunch cocktails to match.

A specialty beer shop and tap room for those interested in craft beer. Drink inside their cosy space, or on a sunny day purchase to takeaway and sit along the nearby canal.



Fuchsbau - Planufer 96

Casual local bar by Lanwehr Canal with an outdoor area for summertime - open late until 5:00am. Walk your way up the connecting Graefestraße for plenty of bar and cafe options in the charming Graefekiez.

MARKETS



Türkischer Markt (Turkish Market) - Maybachufer

This colourful and lively market that runs along Maybachufer offers great-value fruit and vegetables and a delicious range of food stalls. On a summers day it's the perfect stop for a casual lunch along the canal. Thursday & Friday between 11:00 and 18:30.



Nowkoelln Flowmarkt - Maybachufer

Local flea market selling everything from clothing to household items, as well as handmade goods and live music. Every 2nd Sunday between 10h - 17:30h, April - Dec.
